





Registration

Greenburgh Central School Board Policy

- Medical documentations must be submitted to the Lee F. Jackson School by June 1, 2024.
 - Physicals must be within the past 12 months (September 1, 2023- current)
 - Required immunizations for Kindergarten are: 5
 DTap, 4 polio, 2 MMR, 2 Varicella & 3 Hepatitis B



Allergies and Medication

- Any student with allergies or needing medication that will be administered during school hours must have two items:
 - Form signed by the Parent/Guardian giving permission for the School Nurse to administer.
 - The MD/NP full description of protocol/procedures to follow in order for the medication to be administered.
- Medication to be brought in the original package to school and left in the nurse's office.
- These forms are located on the district website.



Absences and Early Release

- If your child is sick, please call the school by 9:30 AM or email attendance@greenburghcsd.org.
- If you are unable to call the school, the nurse will attempt to contact you.
- Upon a child's return to school, he/she must bring in an absence note after 3 days.
- Your child should stay home for at least 24 hours ILLNESS FREE.
- Wash hands with soap and water often.
- Once a child is in attendance, they are excused to leave only upon the personal request of a parent/guardian.
- A child leaving the school before the end of the day must be signed out.
