- Exploren otros materiales de lectura con sus hijos, tales como revistas, historietas, novelas graficas, ymas!

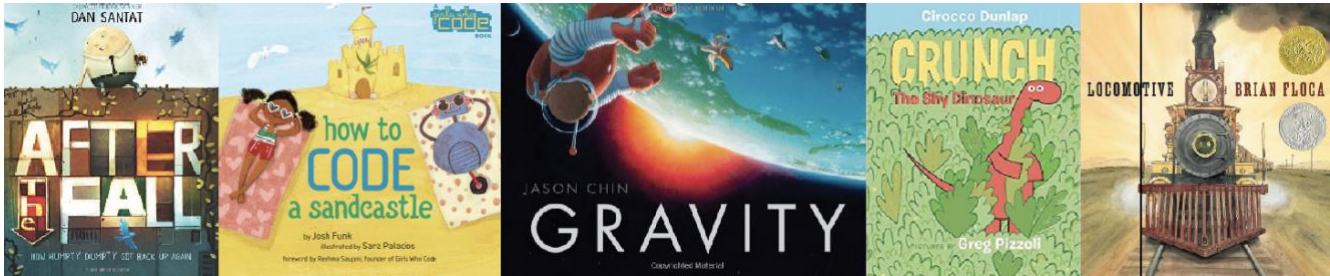
